#### **Letter from your Property Manager**

Hello Del Webb Sunbridge Owners and Residents,

Welcome to the first edition of our monthly Newsletter! Each month we will try to focus on a specific topic or two, but this month. I want to give a general review of what is happening in the community.

First of all, this is a community under development, and we are the pioneer community for the future town of

Sunbridge. It is not a "built-out" community with all the infrastructure intact and Amenities ready to use. It will take several years to get to that point with a projected homesite build out of 1377 homes. We acknowledge that there have been several delays and some mistakes along the way and there probably will be more to come. From those problems we try to learn what can be done better or differently. Progress is being made daily in the building areas, as the Lifestyle House is almost done and work at the Amenity Center having the steel structure now being placed. Work is concentrating on the sport court area so that the racket courts can be safely opened soon.

On the Administrative front, we are planning to hold a "Townhall" type meeting soon with all the residents and the principle business operations; Sales, Construction and Administration, in order to listen to your concerns and to provide personal feedback where we can.

The Architectural Review process is working well. Most are built to the specifications with only a few adjustments that are needed. The landscape turnover of lots are not going as well mostly due to irrigation and water issues and poor sod or plant conditions.

Exclusive Landscaping has some personnel changes for our site that include the site foreman and a dedicated irrigation technician. Greg Everett and Danny Caban will be formally introduced later in this newsletter. We wish Casey Matthews much luck and success in his planned relocation to Texas.

Please be aware that Exclusive is here to maintain the lawns and shrubbery, but is not responsible to replace it if it dies from lack of water or other problems beyond Exclusive landscaping's control. We need your help in maintaining the lawns. If you see your grass getting dry or shrubs dieing it is your responsibility to put in a work order.

On the Construction front, 33 home Closings are scheduled for April. We have had discussions with the construction team about the trash from their work sites and roadway cleaning concerns. They have agreed to bring in a street sweeper once per week for the next month. Having had a punctured tire recently myself. The street cleaning is a necessity as long as the builders are using screws and nails!

Each of the construction managers are also speaking with their contractors on policing their specific work sites better. Having picked up loads of trash from around the community myself. I agree that a better cleaning job has to be done at the trash source. I have seen some improvement, and expect to see more!

In conclusion, the Sunbridge community will be a wonderful place to live, but it will require patience and cooperation from everyone as it is built and grows over the coming years! Enjoy it as much as you can, try to stress less, and let us know when we miss a problem or are off course.



#### Cooks Corner Featured Recipe

# Celebrate National Caramel Popcorn Day on April 6<sup>th</sup> with this easy recipe

#### Ingredients:

- 10 Cups of popped popcorn
- Salt
- 1 Cup Butter (sweet Cream Salted)
- 1 Cup Light Brown Sugar
- 2 tsp. Vanilla
- ½ tsp. Baking Soda

#### **Directions:**

- 1) Make Popcorn.
- 2) Salt popcorn and set aside.
- 3) Melt 1 Cup of butter in a medium saucepan over medium heat.
- 4) Add 1 cup of brown sugar and stir until thoroughly mixed.
- 5) Stirring continuously, bring the butter and sugar mixture up to a boil on medium heat.
- 6) When it reaches a boil allow it to cook for 5 minutes without stirring on medium heat

#### **Directions (continued):**

- 7) Add the 2 tsp of vanilla at the 4-minute mark and stir to mix.
- 8) Continue to boil for one additional minute and then add the ½ teaspoon of baking soda
- 9) Drizzle the caramel mixture over the popcorn. Use a spoon to gently fold the popcorn with the mixture until the kernels are all covered.
- 10) Pour the popcorn out onto a cookie sheet covered with aluminum foil or a silpat liner.
- 11) Let the popcorn cool
- 12) Serve.

Reminder, because we are in a very dry and hot weather period with no significant rainfall predicted we will be changing the times on all irrigation. Turf will go up to 40-minutes, drip lines will come down to 45-minutes and they will run 3-days a week. Danny will be out to make these changes on all homes. They will be turned back down once the rainy season begins or the turf condition improves. We are also using a water tanker truck to help save the grass.

We have also been experiencing water pressure issues. Unfortunately, these issues are not something within our control. Toho and Tavistock are working on solutions, one of which ties in with the work being completed on Narcoossee currently. The water treatment plant is currently on schedule to be completed towards the end of the year.

The month of April begins our weekly maintenance schedule. Our maintenance crew will be on property every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Please see the calendar for their schedule. As we get into the rainy season this schedule is subject to change depending on weather.


